Today's India is an empowered India. We wish to make it even more powerful with conscientious, smart and confident citizens who would exhibit their hidden talents through this newsletter.

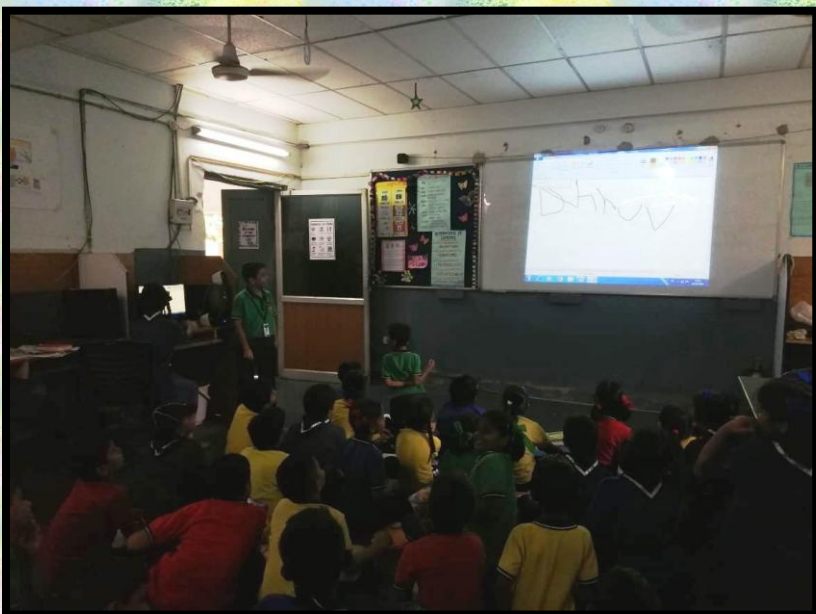

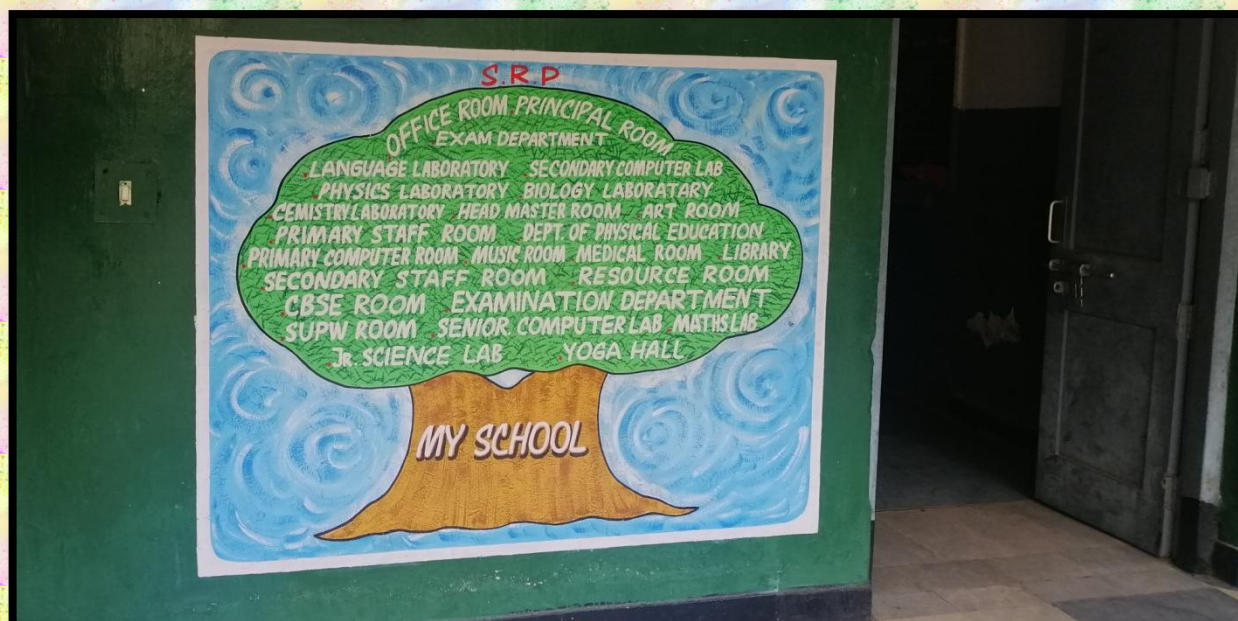
